At last the long-awaited album by SQUEEZE is available. Featuring:

With the combined talents of Roger Bechirian and Elvis Costello handling production, the final result is EAST SIDE STORY! Our fourth album, it is, however, our first with new keyboards player Paul Carrack, whose soulful vocal and keyboards contributions add another dimension to SQUEEZE's already expanding universe.

With fourteen new songs from the prolific quills of the Difford/Tilbrook songwriting team, this album is so full of hooks that it is surely a must for keen anglers everywhere, as well as for the more straightforward pop music record collector.

Working in the backstreets of Acton, London, in one intense three-week period with producers who encouraged a broadening of style for SQUEEZE, has seen the band emerge with a new sound while retaining some of the characteristics that make SQUEEZE unique.

Witness the country-styled "Labelled With Love," the soulful sway of "Tempted," the wistful, orchestrated "Vanity Fair," or the exuberant bounce of the single, "Is That Love." So here it is: the album to flabbergast the doubters and confirm the converted . . . EAST SIDE STORY.
