





HE LATER WENT ON TO CO-WRITE THE NO. 1 SONG "HYPNOTIZE" FOR THE NOTORIOUS B.I.G. ALPERT HAS OWNED AND OPERATED LOS ANGELES-BASED SCREAM STUDIOS FOR 21 YEARS, DURING WHICH HE HAS COORDINATED THE RECORDING OF MORE THAN 700 ALBUMS AND SINGLES. ARTISTS WHOSE MUSIC HAS BEEN RECORDED OR MIXED AT SCREAM INCLUDE NIRVANA, U2, PAUL MCCARTNEY, BOB DYLAN, MADONNA, MICHAEL JACKSON, STING AND RIHANNA. HE ALSO SERVED AS A MIXER, RE-MIXER, ARRANGER OR ORCHESTRATOR ON ALBUMS BY QUEEN, JANET JACKSON, OZZY OSBOURNE AND ICE CUBE, AMONG MANY OTHERS.



IN 2006, SUSIE SINGER CARTER STARTED HER COMPANY GO GIRL MEDIA AND HIT THE GROUND RUNNING WHEN SHE CO-EXECUTIVE PRODUCED AND WROTE TWO SERIES, CAKE AND DANCE REVOLUTION FOR CBS SATURDAY MORNING AND EARNED A PRESTIGIOUS EMA NOMINATION FOR 2007 Marked Her Foray into the World of FEATURES WRITING THE SCREENPLAY AND PRODUCING BRATZ THE MOVIE FOR LIONSGATE AND AVI ARAD PRODUCTIONS. SINCE THEN, SHE'S CREATED, WRITTEN & PRODUCED VARIOUS PROJECTS INCLUDING THE HALF-HOUR ANIMATED PILOT SURVIVING HAWKING FOR FOX TV STUDIOS STARRING BRYAN CRANSTON, ADAM BRODY AND IN 2010, SHE SERVED AS CO-CHRISTINE TAYLOR. A&M THE SERIES IS A PROJECT SUSIE HAS ALWAYS WANTED TO PRODUCE AS A LOVE LETTER TO HER FATHER, HOWARD HOLZER. HOWARD, A RENOWN INNOVATOR IN THE RECORDING INDUSTRY, WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR DESIGNING A&M STUDIOS AND ALSO SERVED AS CHIEF ENGINEER. A&M RECORDS REPRESENTS SOME THE BEST (AND LAST) MEMORIES OF HOWARD, WHO WAS TRAGICALLY KILLED IN A PLANE CRASH AT THE AGE OF 46. HOWEVER, HOWARD LEFT AN INDELIBLE MARK ON THE INDUSTRY WHEN HE DEVELOPED THE CSG SYSTEM WHICH ENABLED THE TRANSITION FROM MONAURAL TO STEREOPHONIC RECORDING. BILLBOARD MAGAZINE CALLED HIM "THE GENIUS OF SOUND".
