While no agreement exists as to the identity of history's greatest singer, there is unanimity on the worst. The excursions of the soprano Florence Foster Jenkins (1868-1944) into lieder and even high coloratura culminated on 25 Oct. 1944 in her sell-out concert at the Carnegie Hall, New York, U.S.A. The diva's (already high) high F was said to have been made higher in 1943 by a crash in a taxi. It is one of the tragedies of musicology that Madame Jenkins' Clavelitos, accompanied by Cosme McMoon, was never recorded for posterity.

The most protracted silence in a modern sheet music is one entitled 4 minutes 33 seconds in a totally silent opus by John Cage (U.S.A.). Commenting on this trend among young composers, Igor Fyodorovich Stravinsky (1882-1971) said that he looked forward to their subsequent compositions being "works of major length".

### Earliest jazz records

The earliest jazz record made was Indiana and The Dark Town Strutters Ball, recorded for the Columbia label in New York City, N.Y., U.S.A., on or about 30 Jan. 1917, by the Original Dixieland Jazz Band, led by Dominick (Nick) James La Rocca (1889-1961). This was released on 31 May 1917. The first jazz record to be released was the O.D.J.B.'s Livery Stable Blues (recorded 24 Feb.), backed by The Dixie Jass Band One-Step (recorded 26 Feb.), released by Victor on 7 March 1917.

### Origins

The gramophone (phonograph) was first conceived by Charles Cros (1842-1888) a French poet and scientist, who described his idea in sealed papers deposited in the French Academy of Sciences on 30 Apr. 1877. However the realisation of a practical device was first achieved by Thomas Alva Edison (1847-1931) of the U.S.A. The first successful machine was constructed by his mechanic, John Kruesi on 4-6 Dec. 1877, demonstrated on the 7 Dec. and patented on the 19 Feb. 1878. Pre-recorded tapes were first marketed by Recording Associates in New York City, U.S.A. in 1950.

### Earliest

The first practical hand cranked, wax coated cylinder phonograph was manufactured in the United States by Chichester Bell and Charles Sumner Tainter in 1886. The forerunner of the modern disc gramophone was patented in 1887 by Emile Berliner (1851-1929), a German immigrant to the U.S.A. Although a toy machine based on his principle was produced in Germany in 1889, the gramophone was not a serious commercial competitor to the cylinder phonograph until 1896.
