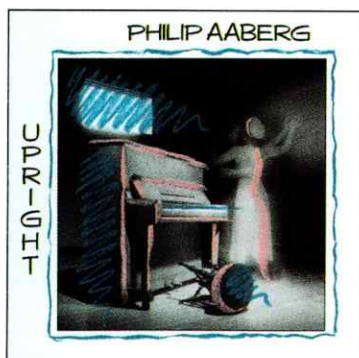

As our flagship label, Windham Hill continues to stand for a family of music, musicians, and arrangements so unique that we occupy a special section in many retail record outlets. But we continue to evolve. In almost 14 years since recording our first solo guitar music, we have expanded to include both solo and multiple string, keyboard, wind, and vocal selections — with and without electric instrumentation and synthesizers. The subjects of our recordings take listeners into varied traditional as well as new and untapped musical landscapes.

Philip Aaberg

With this latest release, pianist, improviser, and composer Philip Aaberg adds yet another colorful patch to his career quilt. Full of boogie-woogie piano unlike his previous recordings, *Upright* reflects the artist's talent and vision for combining his classical music education with his keen interest in blues and rock. Listeners will feel a splash of Jerry Lee Lewis, Garth Hudson, and Professor Longhair in the midst of Aaberg's refreshingly new touch.

From the title release, to "Dancing As If We Didn't Know," to "Welcome to the Church of St. Anytime," Aaberg demonstrates why he has been called both a superb technician and an inspired melodist. The lively and passionate commitment of Philip Aaberg to the keyboard, which began with his first improvisation at age four and a first concert at age seven, continues to win him many followers. In short, listening to *Upright* makes you want to dance one minute, and to dream the next.

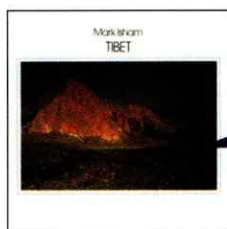
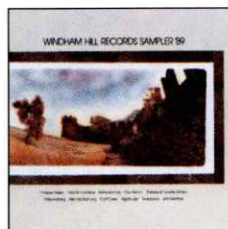

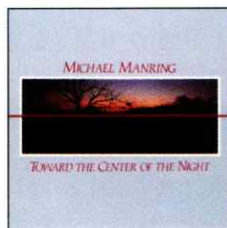

Tibet Mark Isham WH-1080

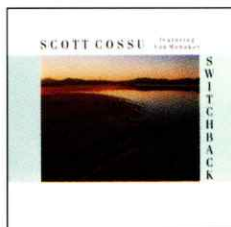

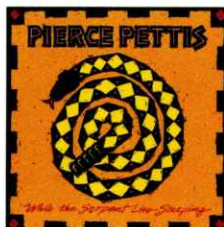
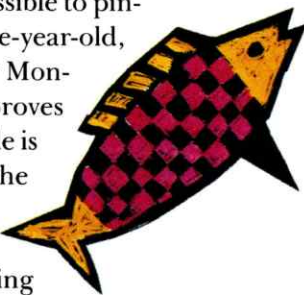

Let Them Say Montreux WH-1084

Continuing in a style almost impossible to pinpoint, the five-year-old, five-member Montreux band proves that the whole is great—and the sum of the parts even greater. Joining forces for this powerful collaboration of melody and percussion are Michael Manring on bass, pianist Barbara Higbie, violinist Darol Anger, guitarist/mandolinist Mike Marshall, and Tom Miller on steel pans and vibes.



While the Serpent Lies Sleeping Pierce Pettis WH-1087

Singer/songwriter Pierce Pettis has established himself as an artist of unusual promise. Cuts on this release showcase a folk style influenced by John Stewart, Dion, Joan Baez, Alex and Kate Taylor, and Velma Frye—all of whom have recorded his songs. Pettis released two previous recordings before making this debut on Windham Hill.

Now in their tenth year of performance and recording, the Nylons sing a unique hybrid of rock n'roll

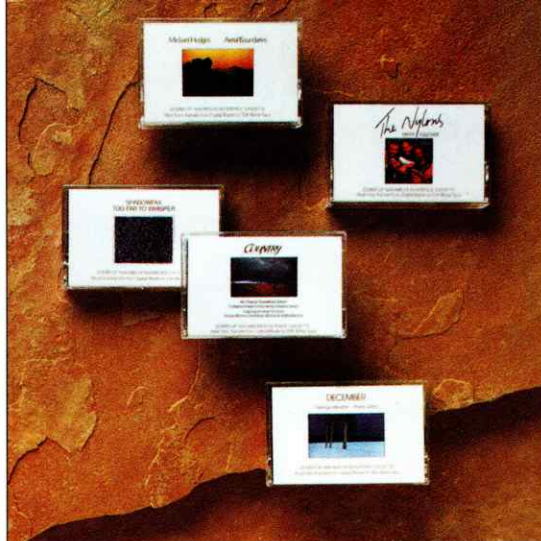


and a cappella—thus the name of their latest work. "Count My Blessings," "Poison Ivy," "Dream," and

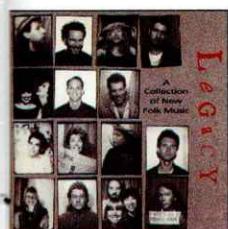

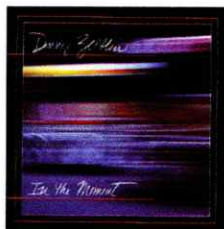

WINDHAM HILL JAZZ

Launched in 1987, Windham Hill Jazz has acted on a simple premise: We are building a small family of new and developing artists whose personal styles may be diverse but who, in common, draw significantly from the jazz art form. Tuck & Patti, for example, have revitalized the duet of guitar and voice to cross the borders of jazz, pop, and R&B. Pianist Denny Zeitlin, the Turtle Island String Quartet, and steel drummer Andy Narell also add to this diversity.

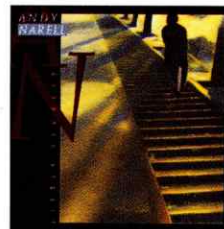
In the Moment Denny Zeitlin WH-0121

In his second recording for Windham Hill Jazz, pianist, composer, and improviser Denny Zeitlin continues his evolution as a world-class jazz stylist, but returns to the classic trio and duo formats. Along with Zeitlin, *In the Moment* highlights bassist Joel DiBartolo and drummer Peter Donald on trio compositions, and bassist David Friesen on the duo selections.

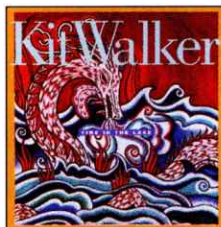

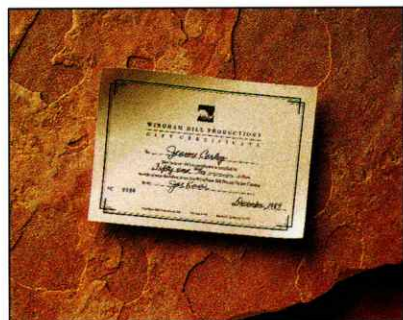

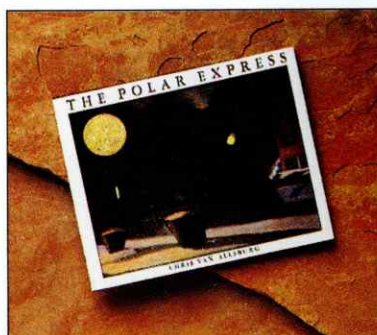
