Everything Old Is New Again

The Very Best of Cream proves that Cream truly does *always* rise to the top. There have been several Cream compilations in the past 25 years, but The Very Best is the first specially compiled collection for CD. Eighty minutes of music have been digitally remastered using the new Apogee UV 22 process giving this entire collection a new, vibrant and immediate sound. The Very Best of Cream spans the band's four album career from Fresh Cream to Goodbye. Clapton's continuing celebrity and visibility (his recently-released Cream of Clapton shipped 100,000), coupled with Ginger Baker's most recent trio recording with Charlie Haden and Bill Frisell on Atlantic, and the re-release of Jack Bruce's Willpower on A&M/Polydor give the dynamic Cream trio a heightened visibility in 1995. And with Clapton's current Warner Bros. release still riding high on the charts, a Clapton auditorium/arena tour planned for Summer (he returns to his blues roots on this one), and the upcoming publication of Ginger Baker's controversial autobiography, the original members of Cream continue in the spotlight.
