Elton's career, which has been notably quiescent for the last few years, is, as a result, becoming hotter than ever. The three songs which Bell and James wrote especially for Elton, were among six that Elton recorded in the Fall of 1977 with Thom Bell, Leroy's uncle, producing.

Bell and James debut album, Bell and James, was released last year by A&M and contained their smash hit single "Livin' It Up (Friday Night)." The pair had been established songwriters for some time, having written for the likes of The Spinners and The O'Jays. They sent a demo tape of new songs to A&M's publishing division for consideration but when the label's A&M department heard the self-produced tape on which Bell and James played all the instruments and sang all the vocals, the company signed them as recording artists. Their album was also recorded solely by Bell and James.

Both played and sang on the Elton John sessions and are credited with guitars and background vocals on the EP.

Bell and James' second album, tentatively titled Only Make Believe is almost completed at this time. The Seawind horn section and ex-Doobie
