



## LET THEM SAY Montreux WH-1084



Concentrating on melodic structure and adding a rich drum and percussion sound, Let Them Say is Montreux's powerful new recording. Producer Steve Rodby (bass player with Pat Metheny) brought to the studio his keen musical sense and ability to draw a unified sound from the five band members, further defining Montreux's unique style.

From the technically brilliant "King Sod" by Darol Anger, the up-tempo "Astronomics" by Michael Manring, Mike Marshall's "October Wedding" to the full textured title song by Marshall and Higbie, Montreux's new release is a delight. The Yellowjackets' William Kennedy laid down drum tracks and Tom Miller's contribution on percussion (steel pans, vibes) defined his major role as the newest member of Montreux.

## ARTIST PROFILE: Michael Hedges

With four solo albums on Windham Hill, the vocal release Watching My Life Go By (OA-0303) on Windham Hill's Open Air label, and the soundtrack on Rabbit Ears "Storybook Classics" for the children's story Santabear's First Christmas (WH-0700), Michael Hedges remains one of Windham Hill's most popular, versatile and prolific artists. From versions of Jimi Hendrix's "All Along the Watchtower" or Sheila E's "Love Bizarre" to original compositions "Aerial Boundaries" or "Because It's There, "Hedges' innovative style and technical fluency is highly respected in musician's circles.

David Crosby and Graham Nash recently enlisted Michael's assistance for their next collaboration. Featured on that release will be a Crosby/Hedges song as well as



## LOVE WARRIORS Tuck & Patti WH-0116



Their debut album captured this duo's extraordinary command of jazz, pop, gospel and R&B elements, while offering eloquent proof that a single voice and guitar can rival the most lavish productions in sheer emotional power.

For its sequel, guitarist Tuck Andress and singer Patti Cathcart extend their signature style to a fresh batch of songs that mirror the couple's diverse influences: in addition to exciting new original songs, Love Warriors offers indelible interpretations of "They Can't Take That Away From Me," Stevie Wonder's "If It's Magic," the Beatles' "Honey Pie," a dramatic medley of Jimi Hendrix' "Castles Made of Sand" and "Little Wing" that display both the delicate melancholy and liquid guitar phrasing of the late rock master. From the delicate title song to Tuck's stunning instrumental of Carlos Santana's "Europa," Love Warriors captures all the intimacy and power of their live shows.



## FIRE IN THE LAKE Kit Walker WH-0117



Composer, arranger and keyboard player Kit Walker brings new depth and an ambitious scope to his second Windham Hill Jazz album, Fire in the Lake. While retaining the same buoyant rhythmic sense that explains the title of his debut, Dancing on the Edge of the World (WH-0109), Walker teams here with labelmates Paul McCandless (reeds), Ray Obiedo (guitar) and Andy Narell (steel pans), along with bassist Keith Jones and drummer Steve Smith, to forge a powerful, personal statement in contemporary fusion. The switch to a more focused ensemble attack is particularly effective in terms of McCandless' heightened role, but it's Walker's compelling original songs that provide the album's core.


