

# SWITCHBACK Scott Cossu WH-1081



Although all of keyboardist Scott Cossu's earlier works are recalled by *Switchback*, most evident are the jazz influences of *Islands* (WH-1033) and the guitar/piano lines of *She Describes Infinity* (WH-1063). Scott and guitarist Van Manakas work closely together on *Switchback*, and their musical compatibility comes across strongly on this, their second outing. Other past associates present on the recording are Dave Valentine (who acts as producer as well as contributing his extraordinary flute tracks), Jim Brock (percussion), and Eugene Friesen (cello). Scott's keyboards are right in sync with the performances of his co-players, and the band delivers the songs with the immediacy of a live recording.

Exploring rhythm and blues, jazz, dance rhythms, folk and classical settings, *Switchback* does it all, and does it all well! With a nod to his past, Cossu lays a solid musical groundwork for his future recordings.

# TIBET Mark Isham WH-1080

It is difficult indeed to create music that conjures a sense of place. It is rarer still to create a sense of a place only imagined by most Westerners, a place of isolation and mystery. Yet that is exactly what Mark Isham has accomplished in his remarkable soundtrack recording from the Windham Hill video *Tibet* (WV-59).

Guitarists David Torn and Peter Maunu add to Isham's own synthesizer and trumpet work, creating a compelling sketch of a remote place where heaven and earth meet, where the vast landscape of high plains and snowcapped peaks encircle a besieged religious culture that has no parallel in the West.





# PERFECT CRIME Ray Obiedo WH-0115

Ray Obiedo's debut album for Windham Hill Jazz introduces eight original compositions, focusing on Obiedo's talents as composer, arranger, guitarist and keyboardist. "There is a fusion flavor to the album with a taste of Afro-Caribbean and 'East Bay funk'," remarks Andy Narell, who co-produces the album with Obiedo.
