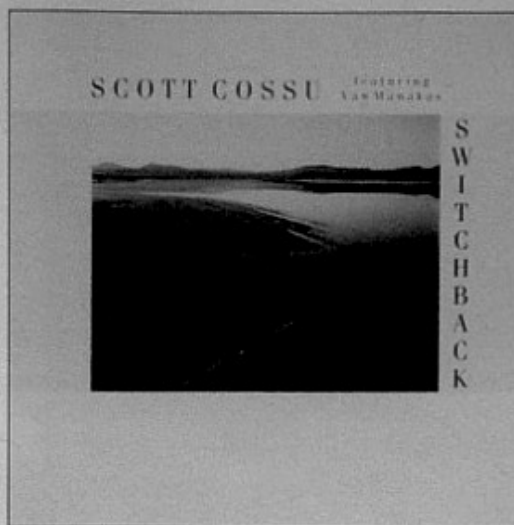

It is difficult indeed to create music that conjures a sense of place. It is rarer still to create a sense of a place only imagined by most Westerners, a place of isolation and mystery. Yet that is exactly what Mark Isham has accomplished in his remarkable soundtrack recording from the Windham Hill video *Tibet* (WV-59).

Guitarists David Torn and Peter Maunu add to Isham's own synthesizer and trumpet work, creating a compelling sketch of a remote place where heaven and earth meet, where the vast landscape of high plains and snow-capped peaks encircle a besieged religious culture that has no parallel in the West.

In 1986 Michael Manring released his remarkable debut album, *Unusual Weather* (WH-1044). The recording underscored Michael's position as one of the finest electric bass players recording today as well as a composer of rare ability.

Toward the Center of the Night, Michael's newest Windham Hill release, draws upon piano, electronic keyboards and voice to complement his unique string hammering and chordal bass technique.

With assistance from Paul McCandless, woodwinds, Coco Roussel, drums, Jane Sciolari, voice, and Montreux percussionist Tom Miller, *Toward the Center of the Night* highlights Manring's strong compositional skills. From the full textured fire of "Funk & Disorderly" and "Life in the Trees" to the intricate compositions of "Blue Orleans" and "Near," this release will gather new fans and delight those already familiar with Michael Manring.

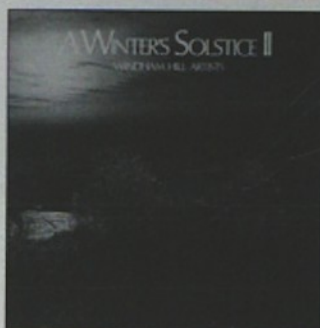

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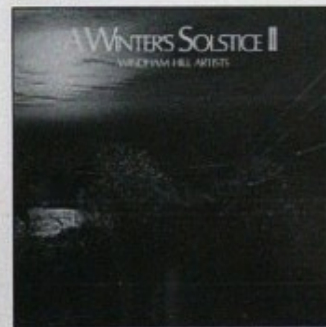

Ray Obiedo's debut album for Windham Hill Jazz introduces eight original compositions, focusing on Obiedo's talents as composer, arranger, guitarist and keyboardist. "There is a fusion flavor to the album with a taste of Afro-Caribbean and 'East Bay funk,'" remarks Andy Narell, who co-produces the album with Obiedo. Saxophonist Marc Russo and drummer William Kennedy from The Yellowjackets, and Narell all lend their talents on *Perfect Crime*.

A native of the San Francisco Bay Area, Ray Obiedo currently leads two bands - the instrumental fusion ensemble KICK, and the vocal pop group, Rhythmus 21. Obiedo's instrumental compositions have been recorded by Pete Escovedo, Julian Priester, Bill Summers, and Andy Narell ("La Samba" and "Once a Dancer"). His vocal tunes have been recorded by The Whispers, Teresa Trull and Linda Tillery. He has also performed with Herbie Hancock, Harvey Mason, Pete and Sheila Escovedo, Rodney Franklin, and Linda Tillery.

Turtle Island String Quartet

Released on Windham Hill Jazz one year ago, *Turtle Island String Quartet* (WH-0110) received critical acclaim as the string quartet's debut album of jazz standards, bebop, avant-garde and original tunes. In addition to receiving a Grammy nomination for their arrangement of Dizzy Gillespie's "A Night In Tunisia," the quartet recently captured Leonard Feather's "Golden Feather" award for best instrumental jazz recording of 1988.

1989 looks to be an exciting year for the the group with *Metropolis* adding more contemporary material to their repertoire, including an exceptional version of Pat Metheny's "Jaco," a funky interpretation of Lee Morgan's classic "Sidewinder," works by John Coltrane, Horace Silver and Duke Pearson, as well as a few Turtle Island String Quartet originals.

David Balakrishnan (violin), Darol Anger (violin), Irene Sazar (viola) and Mark Summer (cello) are the Turtle Island String Quartet. They seek to expand the conventional image of chamber ensembles. "We don't sound like classical musicians trying to play jazz," says Balak-

TUCK & PATTI



Following tremendous response to their debut album *Tears of Joy* (WH-0111), Tuck & Patti are in the studio recording their new album slated for release later this year. Here's a sample of what the critics say:

"There's no dubbing, no stopping, no editing. We decided we wanted to be true to the way we are when we perform—that is, to improvise and be right on the edge ready to go," says Patti Cathcart, half of the musical team Tuck and Patti, about the album Tears of Joy (Windham Hill Jazz), which she recorded with her husband and musical partner, Tuck Andress. She sings. He plays the guitar. The simplicity of their act belies the lushness of their sound, which has received rave reviews. The album has made a dent on the Billboard jazz chart, and the couple were featured on NBC's Today show this past summer. "Patti and I had the conviction that this would happen," says Andress. In fact, they were so committed to their no-frills production that they rejected recording contracts with companies that wanted to add more singers and musicians. They met in a band in San Francisco, where they live. The band didn't last, but the friendship between the two endured and grew into love; they married in 1981. Cathcart says of the successful combining of their personal and professional lives, "We've been very blessed."

THUMBELINA
Kelly McGillis/Mark Isham

This early Hans Christian Andersen tale takes us into a world of characters which reflect a world much like our own. From the bullies and manipulators like Toad, Mole and Junebug to the delightful and kindly Swallow, Fieldmouse, Fish and Butterfly, Kelly McGillis' narration captures all the subtleties in the large cast of characters of *Thumbelina*.

Thumbelina also marks the third recording Mark Isham has scored for our children's line. The two previous soundtracks were *The Steadfast Tin Soldier* (WH-0702) and *The Emperor and the Nightingale* (WH-0706). With assistance from Charlie Haden, Peter Maunu, Paul McCandless and Kurt Wortman, Isham's skill as composer and interpreter of the visual is underscored anew.

Thumbelina is the twelfth release from Windham Hill's "Storybook Classics" series produced by Mark Sottnick for Rabbit Ears Productions.

"A long time ago in Denmark a childless couple, through a witch's spell, became blessed with a radiantly beautiful girl. She was no bigger than a thumb, so she was called Thumbelina. Snatched from her family by an ugly toad who wanted to marry her, Thumbelina escapes, be-friending various creatures of the forest. Ultimately, she meets the king of the flower angels, with whom she finds happiness forever."

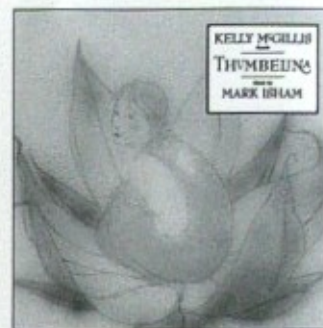
The Rabbit Ears "Storybook Classics" series received the following distinctions in 1988:

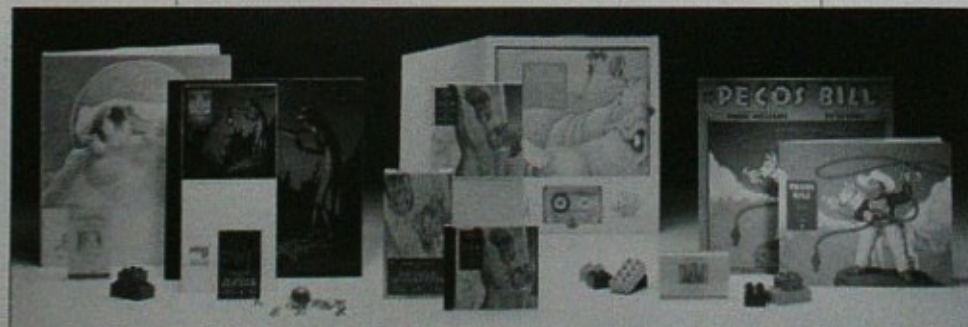

You may wish to purchase videos directly through the catalog, but the NTSC format of U.S. tapes is compatible only with the systems in certain countries, generally those in South America and several in the Far East. Australia will see the children's video line released in March.

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PROFILE: MONTREUX

The diverse musical roots of Montreux combine to form a unique and inspired sound. Darol Anger's groundbreaking acoustic string music, Barbara Higbie's distinctive piano and vocal performance, Mike Marshall's remarkable guitar, mandolin, mando-cello work, Michael Manning's unique fretless electric bass technique, and percussionist Tom Miller are Montreux.

They are currently in the studio recording their next album, slated for release later this year. Individually, Montreux members have their own projects cooking:

Toward the Center of the Night (WH-1083), is Michael Manning's second solo outing. The recording furthers the musical explorations by one of the finest electric bass players in contemporary music. He is assisted by reed player Paul McCandless. Manning's solo debut, *Unusual Weather* (WH-1044) was released in 1986.

The acclaimed Turtle Island String Quartet (Darol Anger, David Balakrishnan, Irene Sazar, Mark Summer) just released *Metropolis* (WH-0114), their second album for Windham Hill Jazz (see page 1). For the third consecutive year Darol Anger captured honors as "Best Jazz Violinist" in the 1988 Frets Magazine Reader's Poll.

Barbara Higbie is currently working on her first solo album slated for release later this year. Those who have had the opportunity to see Montreux in concert have been treated to a glimpse of Barbara's compelling voice and songwriting skills.

Mike Marshall continues his instrumental forays as he tours, writes and performs with both the Modern Mandolin Quartet and Montreux. The Modern Mandolin Quartet has been described as playing "legitimate music on illegitimate instruments." Their debut recording *Modern Mandolin Quartet* (LL-0095) was released on the Lost Lake Arts label in 1988, including works by Bach, Debussy, Bartok and Hindemith.

The newest member of Montreux, Tom Miller, also tours with Andy Narell's steel-drum band Pan Attack. Most recently, percussionist Miller appeared on Michael Manning's *Toward the Center of the Night*.
