STAIRSTEPS - "From Us To You", the single released in the States before Christmas, is shooting up the PAB charts, and currently at No. 60 with a bullet in "Billboard". They are embarking on a major tour of the States, starting February 13, in their hometown, Chicago.

<u>RAVI</u> — The long-awaited film from the Albert Hall concert is now very near completion. It is half-hour in length, and includes an interview with George. We are hoping this will be ready for TV distribution in Harch, to coincide with the release of the festival album.
