HARDER TO LIVE-SPLINTER-It's been almost a year since Bobby Purvis and Bill Elliott (Splinter) released their first album on Dark Horse Records under the producership of George Harrison. THE PLACE I LOVE was the album, and its commercial and artistic values left little doubt in anyone's mind that Splinter was a musical duo to watch. That first album contained musics obviously, but not specifically influenced in melody and mood by The Beatles, HARDER TO LIVE is the natural extension fo those early musics, but also explores some new musical facets of the duo. There are two solid rock and roll songs: HARDER TO LIVE, a contemporary look at the economic pinch; and GREEN LINE BUS, which deals simply with riding in a vechicle. WHICH WAY WILL I GET HOME, AFTER FIVE YEARS, and SIXTY MILES TOO FAR are exquisite opo ballads, fully orchestrated, featuring Splinter's intricate soaring full-blown harmonies set against a solid rhythm section augmented by strings--and arranged by producer Tom Scott. LONELY MAN is a melodic tip of the hat to the Beatles ballad period of HELP and RUBBER SOUL, and featuring some of the George Harrison regulars in support roles including Billy Preston, Jim Keltner, and Harrison on guitar. Rounding out this second album are HALF WAY THERE, a country rock ballad which well might be termed an English on-the-road ode; the clever riddle song WHAT IS IT (IF YOU NEVER EVER TRIED IT YOURSELF) set to an infectious Reggae beat with Tom Scott doubling in brass on steel drums; and PLEASE HELP ME, a pop rocker with some intricate horn turns (once again) by Tom Scott. Supporting Purvis and Elliott on all cuts are Earl Palmer, Chris Spedding, Ralph McDonald, Robert Wachtel, John Taylor and Bill Dickenson.
