
Sandy Denny was the finest singer ever to emerge from the world of British Folk Rock, the spellbinding voice that drove Fairport Convention to first invent, and then reinvent, traditional music in the late 1960s. From old-fashioned waltzes to modern romances, from wistful ballads to timeless rockers, from gentle blues to grandiose celebrations, Denny's greatest ability was the ease with which she could step into any *milieu* she chose, and make it her own. As a songwriter, she was peerless. Her four solo albums abound with a spectacular eclecticism, ethereal and earthy in the passing of a breath, their lyrics simultaneously darkly intimate and instantly accessible.
